### Wood Toy Making Workshop

#### Course Requirements

- Students required to bring the following materials and PPE to each class:
  - appropriate work clothes i.e. long pants or overalls and long sleeved top
  - workboots
  - protective safety glasses
  - dust masks
  - ear plugs
  - tape measure
  - square
  - pen and notebook

**Note:** Safety glasses, hearing protection and dust mask must comply with relevant Australian Standards.

#### List of toys by children ages:

- **0 to 3 year old**
  - Wood blocks, sorting board, peg and hammer board
- **3 to 5 year old**
  - Toy vehicles, blackboard
- **5 to 8 year old**
  - Marionettes, train and track

***Students should assemble in the central foyer near the stairs, in the building where classes are to be held, in order to check compulsory and appropriate personal protective equipment.***
