Triton Weekend Workshop

Course Objectives

Students will:

- Learn the correct usage of manual and power tools with safe work practices
- Develop the necessary skills for the confident and safe use of the triton work centre, router table and attachments together with super jaws and random orbital sander
- Learn to demonstrate and explain the necessity of the correct setting up of power tools in work centre and router table
- Develop skills in various techniques such as finger/box jointing, cross cutting, ripping, planing, biscuit jointing, angle cutting, table routing and orbital sanding
- Learn to identify incorrect and potentially dangerous practices and encourage safe working procedures
- Complete a small project (a bread board)

Course Requirements

- Course materials, equipment and course notes provided
- Students are required to bring the following materials and Personal Protective Equipment to each class:
 - appropriate work clothes i.e. long pants or overalls and long sleeved top

 - dust masks
 - ear plugs
 - square
 - tape measure
 - pen & paper
